

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in November 2023. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried. Reference to the inclusion of a waiver of an administrative separation board in the plea agreement will only be reported in those cases where a punitive discharge is not adjudged as part of the sentence.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Groton, Connecticut, an E-4, USN, was tried for two specifications of wrongful use of a controlled substance and one specification of false official statement. On 15 November 2023, a panel of members returned a verdict of not guilty.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, OS2 Connor Slater, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of indecent recording. On 6 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 31 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, FT3 Quentin Clark, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance. On 9 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, ABHC Anthony White, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of a violation of a lawful general order. On 21 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a reduction in paygrade to E-6. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, Washington, MA3 Levani Eneliko, USN, was tried for one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 30 November 2023, the military judge found the accused guilty of the sole specification and sentenced him to a reduction in paygrade to E-3.

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, California, YN3 Anthony Grafton, USN, was tried for two specifications of sexual assault. On 3 November 2023, a panel of members found the accused guilty of one specification of sexual assault and sentenced him to total forfeitures of pay, 8 years confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Honolulu, Hawai'i, CTR1 Christopher Elsmore, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of violation of a lawful general order, one specification of violation of a lawful order, and one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 28 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 10 months confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, AOAN Saivance Laday, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of indecent conduct. On 17 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 5 months confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan, MA2 Michael Anderson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to three specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 30 November 2023, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 60 days confinement and a reduction in paygrade to E-2. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
