On 7 October 2024, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-6. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, an E-7, USN, was tried for one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 16 October 2024, the military judge found the accused not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, Virginia, FN Isaac Guevara, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of conspiracy and one specification of false official statement. On 30 October 2024, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 6 months confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
