

**The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in September 2025. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried. Reference to the inclusion of a waiver of an administrative separation board in the plea agreement will only be reported in those cases where a punitive discharge is not adjudged as part of the sentence.**

## **Naval District Washington**

### **General Court-Martial**

## **Navy Region Mid-Atlantic**

### **General Court-Martial**

- None.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, MA2 Jackson Bower, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of negligent dereliction of duty resulting in death. On 8 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 70 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, IL, FN Joshua Jones, USN, was tried for two specifications of violating a lawful general order, two specifications of aggravated sexual contact by force, and two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 26 September 2025, a panel of members returned a verdict of guilty to two specifications of violating a lawful general order, one specification of aggravated sexual contact by force, and one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 26 September 2025, the military judge sentenced him to 5 months confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Navy Region Southeast**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, FL, SR Dalton Hoskins, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification to possessing child pornography and one specification of communicating a threat. On 9 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 42 months confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, FL, STS3 Storm McGinnis, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of attempted indecent viewing. On 24 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, FL, HA Miguel Ayala, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of communicating a threat. On 9 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 86 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Charleston, SC, FN Myles Brown, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 19 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 30 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Mayport, FL, MASN Aleena Anderson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of obstructing justice. On 22 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to no punishment. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, FL, an E-7 was tried for one specification of fraternization. On 26 September 2025, the military judge found the accused not guilty.

## **Navy Region Northwest**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, WA, RS3 Jai Harris, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of larceny. On 15 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement, reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

## **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, WA, CS3 Lance Roland, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of domestic violence – commission of a violent offense. On 23 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 days confinement.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, WA, AZ3 Tyce Futch, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of making a false official statement and one specification of larceny of non-military property. On 30 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a fine of \$6,000 and reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.

## **Navy Region Southwest**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, CA, STGSA Jamauri Walker, USN pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of possessing child pornography. On 29 September, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to total forfeitures, 36 months confinement, reduction in rank to E-1, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, CA, RPSR Edmund James, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. On 8 September 2024, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 14 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.

## **Navy Region Hawaii**

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court Martial in Pearl Harbor, HI, YN1 Olmar Anthony D. Aguilus, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of domestic violence – commission of a violent offense. On 10 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 days confinement and reduction in paygrade to E-5.

## **Navy Region Japan**

### **General Court-Martial**

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, CA, LCDR Christopher Olsen, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of unpremeditated murder. On 10 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to total forfeitures, 23 years confinement, and a Dismissal.

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Okinawa, Japan, MA2 Zachary Antill, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to five specifications of fraternization and one specification of conspiracy to obstruct justice. On 19 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-4. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.

## **Navy Region Europe, Africa, Central**

### **Special Court-Martial**

- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, CS1 Jamian Pryer, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of indecent language and one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 9 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 45 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, OS2 Joseph Pacheco, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 10 September 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to reduction in paygrade to E-3. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative discharge board.
