

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in October 2025. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried. Reference to the inclusion of a waiver of an administrative separation board in the plea agreement will only be reported in those cases where a punitive discharge is not adjudged as part of the sentence.

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, LT Ivan G. B. San Buenaventura, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of possession of child pornography. On 1 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement and a Dismissal.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, Seaman Jajaun D. Toliver, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of indecent recording. On 9 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, Seaman James Maurice USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault by strangulation or suffocation and one specification of violation of a lawful general order. On 6 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 12 months confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, ABEEA Davon L. Weathers, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of violating a lawful general order and one specification of wrongfully gambling to the prejudice of good order and discipline. On 7 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to forfeitures of \$500 a month for two months and a reduction in paygrade

to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, CSSA Qwan L. Pirtle, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 29 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 6 months confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, AO3 Kaoni M. Lathan, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of conspiracy to wrongfully distribute a controlled substance, one specification of false official statement, and one specification of wrongful use of a controlled substance. On 30 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to 80 days confinement, and a reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, VA, AD2 Jalen E. Taylor, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of violating a lawful general order and one specification of obstructing justice. On 30 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Groton, CT, SA Elijah K. Roque-Parker, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to three specifications of making fraudulent use of a debit card to obtain property. On 30 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a reduction in paygrade to E-1.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, FL, QM2 Liam J. Diaz Callahan, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of possessing child pornography and one specification of indecent conduct. On 6 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to two years confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Jacksonville, FL, SR David McClain, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of breach of restriction. On 8 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 30 days confinement.

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, CA, ET3 Vincent Panozzo, USN was tried for one specification of possession of child pornography and one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance. On 10 October 2025, the military judge returned a verdict of guilty to one specification of wrongful possession of a controlled substance and sentenced him to 60 days confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, CA, PS2 Trevon Smith, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to one specification of negligent discharge of a firearm. On 20 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 60 days confinement and a reduction in paygrade to E-1. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Hawaii

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, CTT1 Andre R. Wilson, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of domestic violence. On 24 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 18 months confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, HM3 Jason D. Torres, USN, pled guilty pursuant to a plea agreement to two specifications of a violation of federal law, specifically 18 U.S. Code Section 1030(a)(2) (Fraud and Related Activity in Connection with Computers). On 29 October 2025, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 180 days confinement, a reduction in paygrade to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
