

The following reports the results of every Special and General Court-Martial tried within the United States Navy in March 2026. The cases are separated by the Navy Region in which they were tried. Reference to the inclusion of a waiver of an administrative separation board in the plea agreement will only be reported in those cases where a punitive discharge is not adjudged as part of the sentence.

Naval District Washington

General Court-Martial

Navy Region Mid-Atlantic

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, V.A., FC3 Isaiah C. Fuller, USN, pled guilty to one specification of violating a lawful general order for transporting a non-registered firearm onboard a naval base, one specification of possession of a controlled substance, and one specification of discharging a firearm so as to endanger human life. On 3 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 18 months confinement, a reduction in rank to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Norfolk, V.A., ENS Austin Eckhout, USN, pled guilty to one specification of domestic violence. On 9 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 84 days confinement and Dismissal.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Norfolk, V.A., OSSN Anteria C. Collins, USN, pled guilty to one specification of obstructing justice. On 24 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced her to 125 days of confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.
- At a Special Court-Martial in Great Lakes, I.L., HM3 Zyar E. Billingslea, USN, pled guilty to one specification of assault consummated by a battery. On 30 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 68 days of confinement and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Navy Region Southeast

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Mayport, F.L., BM2 Thomas I. Norton, USN, pled guilty to two specifications of rape of a child and one specification of production of child pornography. On 18 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 35 years confinement, a reduction in rank to E-1, and a Dishonorable Discharge.
- At a General Court-Martial in Jacksonville, F.L., HM3 Ricky C. York, USN, was tried for six specifications of rape of a child under the age of 12 years old. On 20 March 2026, a panel of members found him guilty of three specifications of rape of a child under the age of 12 years old. The military judge sentenced him to 30 years confinement, a reduction in rank to E-1, and a Dishonorable Discharge.

Navy Region Northwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Bremerton, W.A., AOC Rylan S. Davis, USN, pled guilty to one specification attempted distribution of child pornography, one specification of solicitation to distribute child pornography, and one specification of wrongful receiving and viewing of child pornography. On 20 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 24 months confinement, a reduction in rank to E-3, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Bremerton, W.A., MMA2 Elijah E. Jackson, USN, pled guilty to one specification of failing to obey a lawful order by wrongfully possessing and transporting a firearm and one specification of being derelict in his duties. On 16 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to forfeitures of \$2,631 a month for two months and a reduction in rank E-4.

Navy Region Southwest

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., SN Jovany L. Jabro, USN, pled guilty to one specification of sexual assault of a child who attained the age of 12 years old, but had not attained the age of 16 years. On 26 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 18 months confinement and a Dishonorable Discharge

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., MMC Patrick Z. Jackson, USN, pled guilty to one specification of incapacitation from duty due to drunkenness. On 12 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a reduction in rank to E-4.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., an E-5 was tried for one specification of use of a controlled substance. On 17 March 2026, a military judge found the accused not guilty.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., HM2 Jake E. Dimmitt, USN, pled guilty to one specification of being drunk and disorderly. On 20 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 31 days confinement and a reduction in rank to E-5.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., AO3 Ethan K. Erickson, USN, pled guilty to four specifications of assault consummated by a battery. On 25 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 10 days confinement, reduction in rank to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.
- At a Special Court-Martial in San Diego, C.A., BMSN Kevaune S. Williams, USN, pled guilty to one specification of willfully disobeying a superior commissioned officer. On 31 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 83 days confinement and a reduction in rank to E-2.

Navy Region Hawaii

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Honolulu, H.I., ISC Jarrod A. Fowler, USN, was tried for one specification of sexual assault of a child and one specification of sexual abuse of a child involving sexual contact. On 11 March 2026, a panel of members found him guilty of one specification of sexual abuse of a child involving sexual contact. The panel sentenced him to one year confinement, a reduction in rank to E-1, and a Bad Conduct Discharge.

Special Court-Martial

- At a Special Court-Martial in Honolulu, H.I., FCA2 Arthur W. Watkins, USN, pled guilty to one specification of domestic violence involving a violent offense. On 27 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to 7 days confinement. The plea agreement contained a waiver of the accused's administrative separation board.

Navy Region Japan

General Court-Martial

- At a General Court-Martial in Yokosuka, Japan., ET1 Israel Solis, USN, was tried for one specification of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent exposure and one specification of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent communications. On 12 March 2026, a panel of members found him guilty of one specification of attempted sexual abuse of a child by indecent communications. The military judge sentenced him to forfeitures of \$1,000 a month for 19 months, a reduction in rank to E-5, and restriction with hard labor for 60 days.

- At a Special Court-Martial in Naples, Italy, PR2 Jonathan J. Rossan, USN, pled guilty to one specification of use of a controlled substance. On 17 March 2026, consistent with the plea agreement, the military judge sentenced him to a Bad Conduct Discharge.
