UPCOMING COURSE QUOTA SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Advanced Cyber Law: 18-21 November, USCYBERCOM, FT Meade, MD

Course Description: This advanced course is for those whose current or prospective billet or duties involve advising on cyber operations. The course also provides detailed information for cyber-adjacent practice areas of information operations, intelligence activities, space operations, and general national security law at the advanced level. Ensure the following information is provided in your justification to attend this course: Current or prospective billet or duties and whether such duties involve advising on cyber operations, information operations, intelligence activities, space operations, or general national security law. Highest priority will be given to operational and support billets.

Both funded and unfunded quotas are available. Submit completed Quota Submission Form to NJS Registrar at njs-registrar@njsonline.onmicrosoft.com by COB on 30 Sept 2024. This will allow sufficient time for NJS to screen the packages and provide the final registration to CYBERCOM for access processing. To attend the Advanced Cyber Law Course you must currently have an active TS//SCI clearance with SI and TK tickets. This does not mean you are TS//SCI eligible (i.e., you have a TS//SCI clearance but are not currently at a TS//SCI coded billet). This course requires you be filling a billet with the SI and TK tickets. This requirement is not controlled by the Naval Justice School (NJS) or Code 10, and neither entity can request these clearances for you. Personnel who wish to attend this course should have their Special Security Officer (SSO) check their clearance information in DISS prior to submitting a quota to ensure it is up to date and there are no errors.
