National Security and Law of Armed Conflict Course 3-14 March 2025 at TJAGLCS, Charlottesville, VA.

This course is offered twice a year and focuses on the role of lawyers in joint and multinational military operations. Lectures cover topics such as: the law of armed conflict; rules of engagement and targeting; rule of law in stability operations; comparative law; human rights; war crimes; investigations in the deployed environment; operational funding; international agreements; intelligence law; interrogation operations; information and cyber operations law; domestic operations; and air and sea law. Small group seminars complement lectures and students can choose from various electives to focus their area of study.
