# Vehicle Sales in Bahrain

(updated 7/15/2020)

Selling vehicles in Bahrain typically requires the Owner Seller to complete a certificate of sale and sign it in front of a notary. Below explains how RLSO EURAFSWA Det Bahrain supports this part of the vehicle sale process.

## First, Get a Certificate of Sale by ...

- Picking it up in person at:
  - **RLSO EURAFSWA DET BAHRAIN** (see below for office location and check Facebook page for current hours).
  - **Dinar Exchange** located in P911.
- Downloading it from the U.S. Navy JAG Corps website:

## Second, Owner Seller Fills Out (but does not sign) the Certificate of Sale.

## Third, the Owner Seller gets the Certificate of Sale notarized by ...

- Going to **RLSO EURAFSWA DET BAHRAIN** (see below for office location and check Facebook page for current hours and whether notaries are being done by appointment).

**NOTE:** If the Owner Seller is not available to conduct the transaction, then the Owner Seller also needs to designate someone to act on his or her behalf using a **Special Power of Attorney (SPOA)**. This designated person cannot be the buyer. SPOAs can be generated online ([https://www.jag.navy.mil/legal\\_services/SPOA.htm](https://www.jag.navy.mil/legal_services/SPOA.htm)) and then need to be notarized (see above instructions regarding notary services).
