

Instructions on Reporting a Covered Offense to the Office of Special Trial Counsel

Step 1: Does the allegation reasonably allege a covered offense Uniform Code of Military Justice Offense listed below? If in doubt, make notification.

Step 2: Is direct notification to OSTC required or may notification be accomplished by command's report of the offense to NCIS?

Notification of NCIS will satisfy reporting to OSTC	Direct command notification to OSTC is required
Article 118, Murder	Article 117a, Intimate Visual Images
Article 119, Manslaughter	Article 119a, Death or Injury of an Unborn Child
Article 120, Rape and Sexual Assault	Article 120a, Mail, Deposit of Obscene Matter

Step 3: If notification to NCIS will satisfy reporting to OSTC,¹ report the offense to NCIS. Direct notification to OSTC is not required.

Step 4: If a direct report to OSTC is required, complete this form with as much information as you have. **Do not question the suspect or victim or conduct investigation for the purposes of completing this form.** Do not unreasonably delay submission of this form to collect additional information. Submit the form to the appropriate OSTC office using encrypted email or DOD SAFE at <https://safe.apps.mil>. If you cannot use either encrypted email or DOD SAFE, please call your servicing OSTC office for assistance.

In all cases:

- The Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) precludes commanders from taking any disciplinary action on covered, known, or related offenses committed on or after 28 December 2023 until an STC returns or defers the offense to the commander. Do not allow the suspect to transfer, retire, be released from active duty, or re-enlist. If the suspect's End of Active Obligated Service is approaching, please consult your SJA about initiating a legal hold.
- All suspects are presumed to be innocent unless and until their guilt may be proven at trial. This form's use of the term "suspect" does not imply guilt.
- The UCMJ precludes unlawful pretrial punishment of a suspect.
- The UCMJ precludes any action that could constitute unlawful influence.
- The information requested in this form will be used to open a case in our management system. Your provision of this information does not mean you have decided the suspect is guilty of any offense.
- Consult your SJA or servicing OSTC if you have questions about this form or its application to your case.

¹ Secretary of the Navy Instruction 5430.107A of 19 June 2019, "MISSION AND FUNCTIONS OF THE NAVAL CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE SERVICE," requires units and commands to notify NCIS of all major criminal offenses, which include all non-combat deaths and any criminal offense punishable under the UCMJ, or similarly framed Federal, state, local, or foreign statute, by confinement for a term of more than one year. Nothing in this form eliminates the need to notify NCIS of all major criminal offenses.
