Ethics Counselor Course – 21-23 May (N.J.S Detachment Norfolk, VA ****VIRTUAL****).

This course provides training for first-time Ethics Counselors or those who need a refresher before assuming an Ethics Counselor billet. Topics include Ethics Counselor fundamentals, gifts, conflicts of interest, use of government resources, relations with non-federal entities/outside activities, fundraising, financial disclosures, post-government employment, and political activities. This course will combine lectures with practical scenarios to deliver the course material. For Navy judge advocates, this course provides initial ethics counselor certification.

Prerequisites— None.

Target Audience— First-time Ethics Counselors and Ethics Counselors desiring refresher training.
