Judge Advocate Career Training (JACT), 3-7 June 2024 at Newport Rhode Island

Course Description— During this one week course, Reserve judge advocates will receive training in operational law, military justice, administrative law, ethics, and legal assistance topics. This course is mandatory for all Navy Reserve Law Program judge advocates at least once every six years for continuing legal education purposes to stay abreast of updates in the law.

Prerequisites— None.

Target Audience— Reserve judge advocates.
