### UPCOMING COURSE QUOTA SUBMISSION INFORMATION

**Law of Naval Operations Course** – 24-28 March 2025 on board Tactical Training Group Atlantic, Naval Air Station Oceana Dam Neck Annex, Virginia Beach, VA.

This basic to intermediate course provides in-depth coverage of national security law topics relevant to operations in the maritime and amphibious domains. Topics include law of the sea, law of armed conflict and rules of engagement, electromagnetic warfare, operations in the information environment, maritime interception operations, international agreements, and area-specific briefs. Students will participate in exercise-driven application of the materials taught, and receive briefs on current operations and lessons learned from Fleet judge advocates practicing in these areas.

Target Audience— This course is geared toward Judge Advocates going to or assigned to billets requiring analysis and provision of advice on national security law and operational law matters, especially operations in the maritime and amphibious domains. See JAGNOTE 1504 of 1 October 2024, Fiscal Year 2025 Judge Advocate and Legalman Career Continuum Training Requirements. In order to receive Fleet Training Management and Planning System (FLTMPS) credit for this course, students must plan to be present through its conclusion on 28 March 2025, and must not plan to depart the schoolhouse earlier than 1330 on 28 March 2025.
