### UPCOMING COURSE QUOTA SUBMISSION INFORMATION

**Military Justice Orientation Course** – 31 March – 11 April 2025 at the Naval Justice School, Newport, RI.

This beginner course is designed for judge advocates slated for, or currently assigned to, litigation billets. The course fulfills the additional qualification requirements for lead counsel in sexual assault cases.

The course will focus on orienting attendees to the practice of military justice and provide extensive advocacy training and practice utilizing an adult sexual assault fact pattern. Using a combination of lecture and small group breakout sessions, the course is designed to strengthen understanding and build experience on all aspects of a contested court-martial as well as the core competencies required for core counsel in both prosecution and defense billets.
