Paralegal Litigation Support Course (Virtual) – 2-5 December 2024 from the Naval Justice School, Newport, RI.

This beginner/intermediate course is designed for entry-level paralegals assigned to litigation support billets. It focuses on the paralegal's role in the courts-martial litigation process, from case preparation through post-trial processing. The course is designed to strengthen students' understanding in litigation and build their experience in the process of case preparation, trial strategy, and trial execution. The course uses a combination of instruction and a fact pattern to allow students to interactively apply instructional knowledge.

Target Audience— Paralegals slated for, or currently assigned to, litigation support billets with less than two years total experience in a trial support role.
